



Installing dQuery 3.03 While Keeping an Earlier Version

The new dQuery version 3.03 contains some significant updates and additions that could affect the operation of existing processes that use the previous versions of dQuery. Specifically, dQuery 3.03 includes a set of dQuery branded DataDirect ODBC drivers and a new Database Connection Wizard that defaults to the newly branded drivers, where possible, to simplify the database connection process. As a result, you may want to keep your older version of dQuery installed instead of simply replacing it with the new dQuery 3.03 installation.

If you have existing processes that were developed with an earlier version of dQuery, you may want to keep the older dQuery version installed and available while installing dQuery 3.03 in a separate location on the same computer. This allows you to still use your older dQuery version, if necessary, while learning the new features of dQuery 3.03 and adapting and testing your current procedures on the new version.

To install dQuery 3.03 without replacing your earlier versions of dQuery, do not uninstall your existing version of dQuery. Instead, follow the normal installation procedure until you come to the following screen, where you can specify a new Destination Folder, as described below, so the old installation is not replaced:

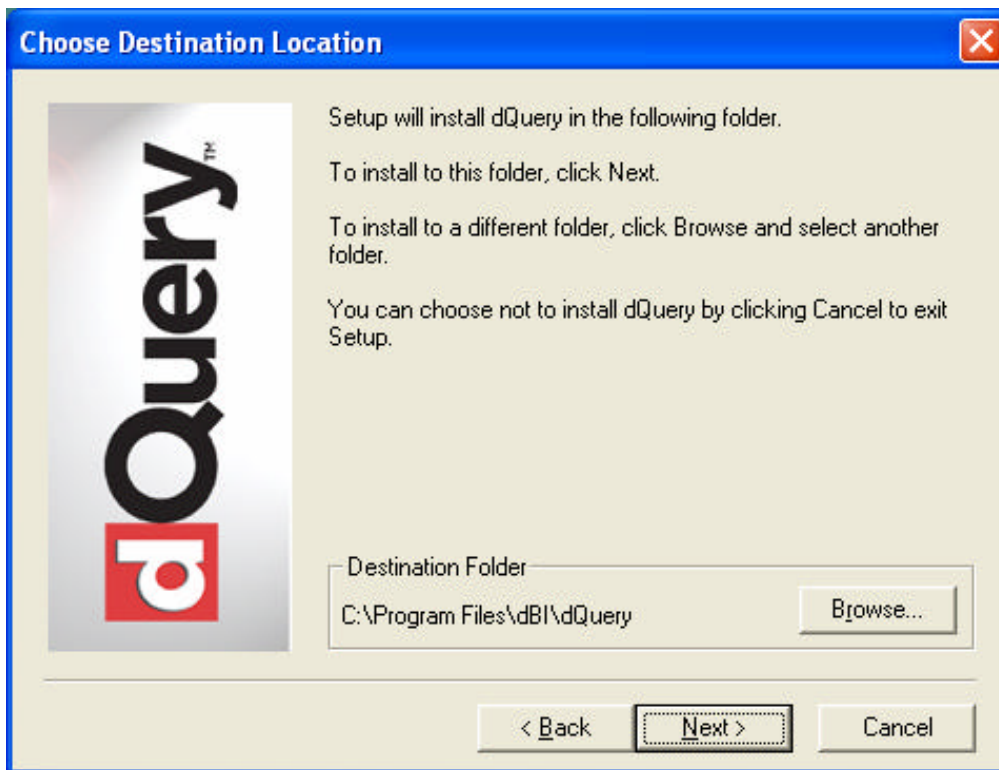


Figure 1 - Click the Browse... button to change the install location.

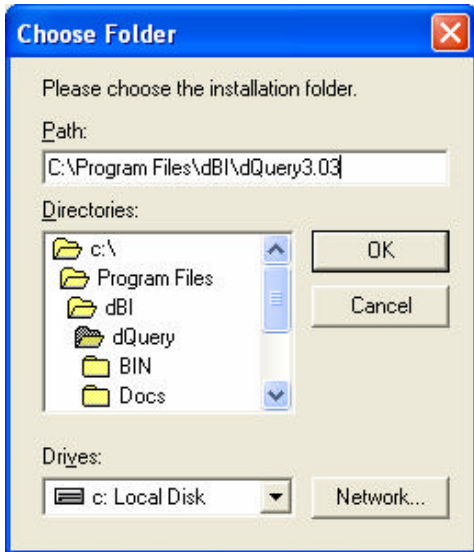


Figure 2 - Append "3.03" to the end of the path and click OK.

Click the Browse... button, which will open the dialog shown in Figure 2, where you can modify the installation path to specify a new Destination Folder.

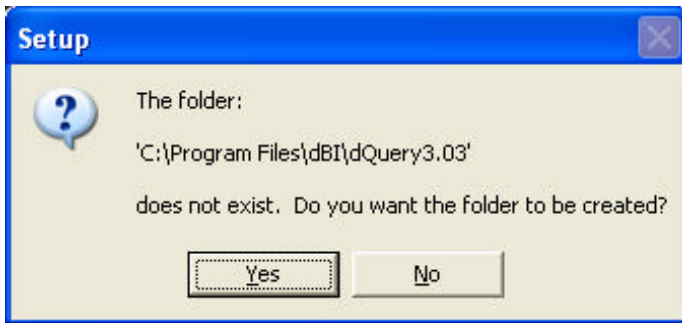


Figure 3 - Click Yes to create the new install folder and continue installation.

When you get to the following screen, append "3.03" to the Program Folder name so you can still run both versions of dQuery from the Windows Start menu:

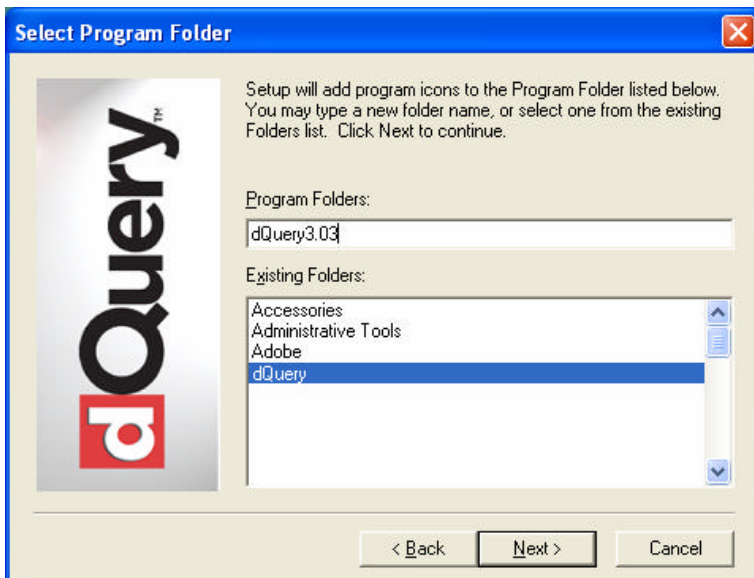


Figure 4 - Append "3.03" to the Program Folder name and click Next to continue.

Once installation of dQuery 3.03 is complete, you should be able to use the new version and still run the older version if necessary.
