



INSTALLATION AND SET UP GUIDE

Step 1

To install dQuery, insert the dQuery CD into your CD drive. For most Windows installations, the dQuery Setup Program will start automatically.

Step 2

If the dQuery Setup Program does not start automatically within 30 seconds, use the Windows Explorer to navigate to the CD drive where the dQuery CD is inserted or locate the folder to which you downloaded the software. Double-click on the SETUP.EXE file to start the Setup Program.

Step 3

dQuery can be installed in two different configurations:

- Business User Install** – is optimized for use by a typical business user. It enables access to dQuery’s capabilities and substitutes friendly dialogs and wizards for options requiring use of the dQuery Property Inspector and Source Code Editor, which are developer tools. Use this install if your enterprise database is centrally located on a corporate computer and someone else in your organization is responsible for setting permissions and security.
- Developer Install** – is optimized for use by a software developer who may need access to dQuery’s internal properties to achieve their objectives. The Developer install includes access to the dQuery Inspector and Source Code Editor which allow a developer to customize the code generated by various dQuery options. Use this install if you are:
 - responsible for management of systems and networks, assigning permissions and safeguarding security.
 - installing dQuery on a single computer with databases located on your local drive or you connect to other computers via a LAN. The Developer Install includes components for installing the dQuery Web Server Side; security, server and user setups and Apache configuration.
- Other Options** – Select this option if you have already installed the product and want to add or configure the following items:
 - The dQuery Runtime engine – Use the runtime engine when distributing an application created with dQuery to other computers.
 - Install dQuery/Web Server Components – Sets up a web server to support running dQuery/Web program.
 - Install Apache Web Server – Installs Apache 1.3 web server software. Apache can be used to setup a web site for running dQuery/Web applications.
 - Setup Apache – Configures Apache for use by dQuery/Web after you have run the “Install Apache Web Server” option.

Click on the dQuery install button of your choice and follow the on-screen prompts.

Step 4

When prompted for a Serial Number, enter the number sent to you in email.

dQuery comes with dBASE, the premier desktop database program and several third-party programs, among them Borland Database Engine and Apache Server.

If you have other applications running that use the Borland Database Engine, the dQuery Setup Program will ask you to close them before continuing.

The following settings can either be left at their default or modified to suit your specific needs:

Location for the *dQuery* files – defaults to “C:\Program Files\dBASE\dQuery”

- Location for the BDE files – defaults to “C:\Program Files\Common Files\Borland\BDE”
- Name of the program folder – defaults to “dBASE dQuery”

Step 5

If you accept the defaults and click Next on each screen of the Installation Wizard, *dQuery* will be installed for you automatically. There is no further setup or configuration that needs to be performed at this time. You can run the program immediately.
